

## CityCycle Brisbane



CityCycle is an initiative from the Brisbane City Council that will allow people to pick up and drop off push bikes at stations throughout the Brisbane CBD.

There will be 2000 bikes and 150 parking stations at Brisbane city, Fortitude Valley, Milton, New Farm, Newstead, South Brisbane, St Lucia, Toowong, and West End that will link with public transport.
